As of January 15, 2007, St. Luke's has received 114 pledges for 2007 for a total dollar amount of \$205,954. Thank you for all of your support!

Our theme for the 2007 Stewardship Campaign was "Sharing the Abundance." The Stewardship Committee conceived a pamphlet on this theme that went to all parishioners, and together with a number of other volunteers, we wrote individual letters to every member of the parish to ask for their support in 2007. We received positive feedback from parishioners about this approach, and we will consider doing the same for the 2008 year.

St. Luke's also featured several witness statements at the 10:00 am service on stewardship themes. We also hope to organize a personal finance lecture series for spring of 2007 that touch on themes like planned giving, elder care, and making room in our budgets for charitable giving.
